Bird surveys, Dog Rocks Flora and Fauna Sanctuary and Honey Woodland, Batesford. 4 November 2019

As part of the Batesford Fyansford Stonehaven Landcare Group's **Lower Moorabool Bio-link Project Biodiversity Grant**, expert bird observers and volunteers will perform regular bird surveys, collecting data to monitor the responses of woodland birds to the establishment of the bio-link and its interaction with remnant bush.
